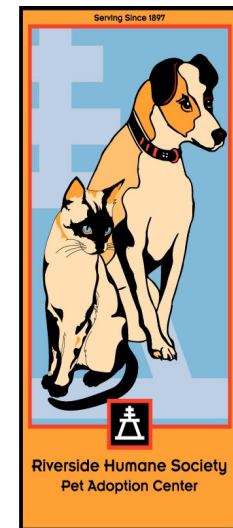

Adoption Center Helper Projects

Thank you for your interest in the Riverside Humane Society Pet Adoption Center. Your group can provide the animals of RHS with a new toy, bed or accessory. Creating gifts for homeless animals is a wonderful service project for groups of all ages.



Pet Accessories

Cat Blankets

Cats appreciate a nice soft blanket to cuddle up with during their stay. Often we will send their blankets home with them upon adoption, so they have something familiar with them in their new home.

Type 1: Small quilts can be made from cotton fabric scraps. This project will require sewing the pieces together.

Type 2: Fleece blankets with tied fringe are a popular alternative to sewing blankets. To make fleece blanket, cut two pieces of fabric longer to allow for the ties. Lay one piece on top of the other and cut strips into the fabric on all four sides. Tie fringes together to make the blanket.

Cat Toys

Cats love to have toys of their own to play with while they are staying at the pet adoption center. We also like to send a toy home with them when they join their new family.

Catnip Squares –Fabric pillows about 3 inches square (or any shape) stuffed with cotton and a little catnip.

Decorated Golf Balls– Please remember to use non-toxic paint!

Dog Bandanas

Our dogs need to look their best. Consider making them a triangular shaped bandana. Bandanas can be made in any color of washable fabric. A good size bandana can be made by folding a 20 inch square diagonally and cutting on the crease to make 2 scarves 20X20X30 inches. Sewn edges make a neat finish. For a non-sew project, use pinking shears to finish the edge. You may choose to wrap you bandana around a treat. These special packages will be given to a dog's new family for a take home treat.

Decorated Tennis Balls–Please use non-toxic paint.

Newspaper Articles–Write an article about RHSPAC for you local school newspaper
