

## **Riverside Humane Society Pet Adoption Center Celebrates June, Adopt-a-Shelter-Cat Month, with Discounted Adoption Fees and Free Accessories for All Adult Cats**

### **Cats 1 year and older come with carriers and cat tree/scratchers, ready to settle into their forever homes**

RIVERSIDE, CA, June 5, 2008 – While this time of year there are kittens galore in need of homes, adult cats, too, are deserving of love and shouldn't be overlooked. Older cats actually are a better choice for households with small children, and for busy or working adults and seniors who may not have the time, patience or energy to deal with rambunctious, high-maintenance kittens.

The Riverside Humane Society Pet Adoption Center (RHSPAC) has many beautiful adult cats of mixed breeds and a variety of colors just waiting for their opportunity at a forever home. To celebrate June, Adopt-a-Shelter-Cat Month, and help these lovable cats get adopted, RHSPAC has discounted the standard adoption fee to \$60. All cats have been spayed or neutered, vaccinated and microchipped, have received medical care, if needed, and are socialized.

But that's not all! RHSPAC will send home all cats one year and older with a cardboard carrier and their own cat tree/scratcher. The retail value of these two items is more than \$60.

"We have dozens of kittens waiting to come back to the center from foster homes and we need to free up space in our cattery," says Denise Perry, director of operations. "It's sad for us to see some of our older cats, who have such great personalities, living here for months on end. While our Kitty Cottages are roomy and the cats have plenty of toys and climbing furniture, and get lots of attention from staff and volunteers, they'd be so much happier and really blossom if they were settled into a home environment."
