ANIMAL CARE

TITLE: Transport Assistant

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

Transport pet/s to and from medical appointments and/or transport to a foster home. May need to pick up medication from Center and deliver medications.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Transport the pet/s to and from medical appointments
2. Transport to a foster parent's home
3. Pick up medication from Center and deliver medications
4. Handle pets responsibly
5. Load and unload pets from vehicle

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Comfortable handling dogs, cats, kittens, and puppies
2. Dedication to the MSRPAC's philosophies
3. Valid driver's license
4. Minimum 18 years of age

TRAINING:

1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session and complete leash-walking training
2. Interview with Wellness Manager or designee

TIME AND PLACE:

1. On Call
2. Various locations in Riverside and neighboring cities (Rancho Cucamonga and Ontario).

COMMITMENT:

1. Available between 8:00am-10:00am and 3:00pm-6:00pm

SUPERVISION:

Direct supervision by the Wellness Manager, indirect supervision by the Foster Care Coordinator.
